From the NJ Turnpike: Take Exit 7A to I-195 West to Exit 60 B (I-295 N), to Exit 65 A, Sloan Avenue. Bear right off the exit. Continue through first light. Make right into Shopping Plaza (formerly the home of Ames Department Store). The RWJ Hamilton Health and Wellness Center is located on the right-hand side.

From New Brunswick, East Windsor and Jamesburg: Proceed South on Route 1. Merge onto I-295 South. Take Exit 65 A, Sloan Avenue East. Bear right off the exit. Continue through first light. Make right into Shopping Plaza (formerly the home of Ames Department Store). The RWJ Hamilton Health and Wellness Center is located on the right-hand side.

From the Jersey Shore: Take I-195 West to Exit 60 B (I-295 N), to Exit 65 A, Sloan Avenue. Bear right off the exit. Continue through first light. Make right into Shopping Plaza (formerly the home of Ames Department Store). The RWJ Hamilton Health and Wellness Center is located on the right-hand side.

Why Would I Want to Attend?

Point #1

You will learn about how to insert a peripheral IV catheter, assess the IV site for early signs of complications, and properly document the assessment and procedure.

Point #2

You will learn in-depth venipuncture theory with multiple opportunities for hands-on participation to enhance the learning process. Locating veins by palpation will be part of the practicum. Please wear short sleeves under a jacket to make veins for identification purposes accessible.

Point #3

Practicum Requirement: Certificates are awarded upon successful completion of the practicum portion of the IV Venipuncture Certification program. Criteria that must be met include: properly holding the device, retracting the skin, identifying the vein (palpation), inserting the device appropriately, and obtaining a blood return on the practice model. The competency checklist must be completed.
